## **Readings for Spring 2018**

We are reading Marx and Engels' *German Ideology* as found in volume 5 of the Marx-Engels Collected Works. This is 578 pages of reading. So, we will split the work into two parts, the first part in the Spring and the second part in the Summer. It is hard to find a convenient cutoff point for halfway through the book. Also, the first roughly 100 pages of the *German Ideology* are an intense study of the basic social conception of Marx and Engels which is at the core of all later work by them, so these first 100 or so pages deserve a more careful reading, in my view. So, we will spend 5 weeks on those first 100 pages, and then the remaining 9 of the Spring semester, on the following 200 pages of the work, up to p. 301. In the Summer semester we will read pp. 301–581, the remainder of the volume.
